Romans 3:21-26

- 1.) **RIGHTEOUSNESS IS NOW REVEALED (ROM. 3:21-22)**
- 2.) **RIGHTEOUSNESS IS FOR EVERYONE (ROM. 3:22-23)**
- 3.) **RIGHTEOUSNESS IS ONLY POSSIBLE THROUGH JUSTIFICATION (ROM. 3:24)**

4.) **RIGHTEOUSNESS IS BY AN ACT OF GOD ALONE (ROM. 3:25)**

- a.) By propitiation: Means to be a sacrifice, a covering, a satisfaction, a payment, an appeasement for sin.
(Heb. 2:17; 1 Jn. 2:1-2, 4:10; Lk. 18:13)

5.) **RIGHTEOUSNESS HAS ONE GREAT PURPOSE (ROM. 3:25-26)**

- a.) To declare God's personal righteousness:
 - 1.) That He forgives sins (Mt. 26:28; Heb. 9:22, 28)
 - 2.) That He is forbearing (Rom. 8:3; Gal. 4:4-6)
 - 3.) That He is just (Isa. 53:4-6; 1 Pet. 2:24, 3:18)
 - 4.) That He is the justifier of believers (Acts 13:39; Rom. 3:28, 5:1; 1 Cor. 6:11; Gal. 3:24)
