1.) FAITH EXCLUDES BOASTING (ROM. 3:27)

- a.) Works cause boasting in oneself (Ro.12:16; James 4:16; Rev. 3:17; Ps. 49:6-7; Prov. 25:14, 26:12, 27:1)
- b.) Faith causes boasting in God (1 Cor. 1:31, 6:20; 2 Thess. 1:12; Ps. 22:23; Ps. 44:8; Jer. 9:24)
- 2.) FAITH JUSTIFIES A MAN WITHOUT THE WORKS OF THE LAW (ROM. 3:28) (Gen. 15:6; Acts 13:39; Ro. 5:1; 1 Cor. 6:11; Gal. 3:24)
- 3.) FAITH REVEALS ONLY ONE GOD WHO DEALS WITH ALL EQUALLY (ROM. 3:29-30)
 - a.) He created all: He is the God of all (Mt. 23:9; Eph. 4:6; Heb. 12:9; Mal. 2:10)
 - b.) He is the only God
 - 1.) All are justified in the same way by faith (Acts 10:34, 15:9; Ro. 2:11, 10:12-13)
- 4.) FAITH UPHOLDS AND ESTABLISHES THE LAW

(ROM. 3:31) (Mt. 5:17; Ro. 8:3; Gal. 3:13, 19, 22, 24; Ro. 10:4, 9-10; 2 Cor. 5:14-15; Gal. 2:20; 1 Jn. 3:16)
