- b.) Law works wrath (Rom. 7:10-11; Gal. 3:10, 12, 5:4)
- c.) Law means transgression (Rom. 7:5, 8, 3:20, 5:20, 7:7;
Gal. 3:19; 1 Tim. 1:9)
