- b.) Immersed, identified with Christ in resurrection
  - 1.) Raised by God's glory (1 Cor. 6:14; 2 Cor. 13:4)
  - 2.) Purpose: That we should walk in newness of life (Col. 2:12; Eph. 1:19-20; Gal. 5:16; Eph. 4:1; Col. 2:6)
- c.) Immersed, identified with the most glorious hope (Rom. 6:5) (Eph. 2:5-6; Col. 3:1; Jn. 14:2-3; 1 Thess. 4:16-17; 2 Tim. 2:11)
