MISSING GOD'S RIGHTEOUSNESS

Romans 10:1-11

1. PAUL'S DESIRE AND ISRAEL'S MISTAKE (ROM. 10:1-3)

- a.) Paul's desire for Israel's salvation (Rom. 10:1) (Jn. 4:22)
- b.) Israel's mistake (Rom. 10:2-3)
 - 1.) Ignorant of God's righteousness (Eph. 4:18; Jer. 5:4; Mic. 4:12)
 - 2.) Establishing their own way of righteousness (Mk. 7:6; 2 Cor. 10:12; Job 9:20; Prov. 20:6, 30:12)
 - 3.) Refused to submit themselves to God's righteousness (1 Tim. 2:4-5)

2. GOD'S RIGHTEOUSNESS IN JESUS CHRIST (ROM. 10:4)

- a.) Christ ended the law in that He is the object toward which the law pointed (Gal. 3:24-25; Col. 2:17)
- b.) Christ ended the law in that He fulfilled and completed the law perfectly (2 Cor. 5:21; 1 Pet. 1:18-19)
- c.) Christ ended the law in that He destroyed the penalty and condemnation of the law against man (Eph. 2:15; Col. 2:14; Rom. 10:4; 1 Cor. 1:30; Phil. 3:9)
