

# ROMANS

## THE GOSPEL IS NOT FOR ISRAEL ALONE - IT IS UNIVERSAL

*Romans 10:12-21*

### **1. PROOF 1: THE LORD TREATS ALL MEN JUST ALIKE (ROM. 10:12)**

- a.) He makes no distinction between men (Rom. 2:2; Acts 10:34-35; Job 34:18-19)
- b.) He is rich to all (Ex. 34:6)
- c.) There is no limit to the riches of His grace (Eph. 1:7, 18, 2:4-7; Phil 4:19)

### **2. PROOF 2: ALL MEN ARE SAVED BY THE SAME PROMISE (ROM. 10:13)**

- a.) "Whosoever . . ." (Jn. 7:37; 1 Tim. 2:4; 1 Jn. 5:1; Rev. 22:17; Isa. 45:22)
- b.) ". . . Shall call upon. . ." (Jn. 3:16, 5:24)
- c.) ". . . The name of the Lord. . ." (Lk. 9:23; Rom. 12:1-2; Phil. 2:11; 1 Jn. 4:15)
- d.) ". . . Shall be saved." (Rom. 1:16)

### **3. PROOF 3: THE WORLD CANNOT BE SAVED APART FROM THE GOSPEL (ROM. 10:14-15)**

- a.) The world cannot call nor believe, nor hear without a preacher (Rom. 10:14)
- b.) The preacher cannot preach unless he is sent (Rom. 10:15)
  - 1.) We are to pray for laborers (Mt. 9:37-38)
  - 2.) We are to go forth ourselves (Mt. 28:19-20; Mk. 16:15)
  - 3.) We are to give to meet the needs of the world (2 Cor. 8:7, 9:6; Eph. 4:28; 1 Jn. 3:17)
- c.) The gospel is the message of peace and "Glad Tidings of Good Things." (Rom. 10:15)
  - 1.) Peace (Jn. 14:27, 16:33)
  - 2.) Good things (Jn. 5:24, 10:10; Gal. 5:22-23; 1 Pet. 1:3-4)
