THE GOSPEL IS NOT FOR ISRAEL ALONE - IT IS UNIVERSAL PART 2

Romans 10:12-21

- 1. PROOF 1: THE LORD TREATS ALL MEN JUST ALIKE (ROM. 10:12)**
- 2. PROOF 2: ALL MEN ARE SAVED BY THE SAME PROMISE (ROM. 10:13)**
- 3. PROOF 3: THE WORLD CANNOT BE SAVED APART FROM THE GOSPEL (ROM. 10:14-15)**
- 4. PROOF 4: SCRIPTURE SAYS THE GOSPEL IS UNIVERSAL (ROM. 10:16-17)**
 - a.) Three steps involved in faith:
 - 1.) The step of hearing (Mt. 13:16, 23; Lk. 10:39; Jn. 1:12; Acts 17:11; 1 Thess. 2:13; James 1:19; Prov. 8:34, 15:31, 18:15)
 - 2.) The step of mental assent (James 1:18, 4:8; 1 Cor. 10:21; Hos. 10:2)
 - 3.) The step of commitment (Jn. 3:15, 36, 5:24, 6:28-29, 11:25, 20:31; Acts 8:37, 10:43, 13:39, 16:31; Rom. 10:9; James 2:17)
 - b.) The gospel is to be obeyed (2 Cor. 6:17-18; Heb. 5:9)
- 5. PROOF 5: ISRAEL'S DISOBEDIENCE PROVES THE GOSPEL IS UNIVERSAL (ROM. 10:18-21)**
 - a.) Not because they did not hear (Rom. 10:18) (Ps. 19:4)
 - b.) Not because they did not know (Rom. 10:19) (Deut. 32:21; Isa. 65:1)
 - c.) Because they were disobedient and unbelieving (Ezk. 33:11; Hosea 6:1; 2 Cor. 5:20; Rev. 3:20)
