Romans 11:1-10

- 1. ISRAEL WAS DISOBEDIENT (ROM. 11:1)**
- 2. PROOF 1: PAUL HIMSELF WAS PART OF THE REMNANT (ROM. 11:1)**
 - a.) Paul was a pure Jew
 - b.) Paul was part of the remnant of God (Acts 9:5-6; Phil. 3:7-9)
- 3. PROOF 2: GOD'S FOREKNOWLEDGE GUARANTEES A REMNANT (ROM. 11:2)**
- 4. PROOF 3: ELIJAH FORESAW THE REMNANT (ROM. 11:2-4)**
(1 Ki. 19:9-18) (Heb. 12:1; 1 Pet. 1:13; Rev. 3:4, 11; Mal. 2:6; Prov. 14:34)
- 5. PROOF 4: THERE IS A REMNANT AT THIS PRESENT TIME (ROM. 11:5)** (Titus 2:11-14; Rom. 9:27)
- 6. PROOF 5: GOD'S GRACE ASSURES A REMNANT (ROM. 11:6-10)**
 - a.) The unbeliever's rejection is willful, always deliberate (Mt. 13:15; Rom. 8:5-8; 1 Jn. 2:15-16; Ps. 69:22; 2 Cor. 4:3-4)
 - b.) The unbeliever experiences a judicial blindness and rejection of God (Mt. 7:2; Rom. 1:24, 26, 28, 2:5-6; Gal. 6:7-8, 3; Ps. 81:11-12; Prov. 29:1)
