GOD IS NOT THROUGH WITH ISRAEL -THERE IS A RESTORATION

Romans 11:11-16

1. PROOF 1: GOD HAS OVERRULED ISRAEL'S STUMBLING OVER CHRIST (ROM. 11:11-12)

- a.) God opens salvation to the Gentiles (Gen. 12:3; Ex. 19:6; Isa. 49:6; Acts 13:46-47, 28:27-28; Lk. 14:21-24)
- b.) God stirs the Jews to be restored (Jn. 16:7-11; Lk. 24:47; Rom. 1:16; Gal. 3:27-28)
- c.) God assures the glorious restoration (Mt. 24:14; Rom. 11:25-26; Jer. 24:7; Zech. 12:10, 13:1)

2. PROOF 2: PAUL TRIES TO STIR THE JEWS TO BE SAVED (ROM. 11:13-15)

- a.) By magnifying his ministry to the Gentiles (Rom. 11:13)
- b.) Paul's purpose:
 - 1.) To stir some to be saved (Rom. 11:14)
 - 2.) To bring about the restoration (Rom. 11:15) (Rom. 5:10; 2 Cor. 5:17-18; Col. 1:20; Eph. 2:16; Jer. 24:7; Ezk. 37:10; Lk. 15:24; Rom. 8:11; Eph. 1:18, 2:4-7)

3. PROOF 3: THE FOREFATHERS, THAT IS THE PATRIARCHS, GIVE A HERITAGE OF HOLINESS (ROM. 11:16) (Num. 15:19-21, NASB)

- a.) Note: It is important for every parent and generation to live Godly lives (Ex. 34:6-7, Ex. 20:5-6; 2 Ki. 17:15; Jer. 32:18-19; Lam. 5:7; Deut. 12:30; Mt. 23:3; Ex. 19:6; Rom. 11:28; Deut. 4:37; Lev. 26:40-42)
