1. IS GOD RIGHTEOUS, THAT IS, JUST? (ROM. 9:14)

2. GOD HAS THE RIGHT TO BE MERCIFUL AND JUST (ROM. 9:15-18)

(Ex. 33:19, 32:32, 32:1-6) (Rom. 13:1)

a.) Man desperately needs to do two things

1.) Seek the face of God for mercy (Isa. 55:7, Lam. 3:22; Mic. 7:18; Eph. 2:4-5;

Titus 3:5; Heb. 8:12)

2.) Guard against becoming hard toward God (Ps. 95:8, 29:1; Rom. 2:5;

Heb. 3:13)

3. GOD HAS THE RIGHT TO DO AS HE WILLS (ROM. 9:19-21)

a.) Man has no right to reply against God (Rom. 9:19-20)

b.) God's right over man is as the potter's right over clay (Rom. 9:21) (2 Pet. 3:9; Rom. 8:28-29; Eph. 1:4-5; Phil. 2:9-11; 2 Tim. 1:9; Titus 1:2; Rev. 1:6, 4:11, 13:8, 19:6)
