- a.) There is a thirst for the Holiness of God, for the Power of God and for the Truth of God (Isaiah 44:3; Matthew 5:6)
- b.) A thirst is born to be filled with the Spirit and to speak The Word with boldness (Psalm 63:1-2)

2. THE MOTIVE FOR REVIVAL

- a.) For the glory of God (Psalm 119:126)

3. WHAT IS REVIVAL? (HABAKKUK 3:1-2)

- a.) A divine intervention in the normal course of religion (Isaiah 63:10,15; 64:1-3)
- b.) An answer to prayer (Habakkuk 3:3-7, 12-13)
- c.) Being willing to pay the price (Malachi 3:10; Psalm 27:13; 2 Chronicles 7:1-3, 12-15)

4. THE TRUE MOTIVE OF REVIVAL

- a.) The outpouring of the Holy Spirit (Acts 2:16-17; 10:45)
 - 1.) Human activity ceases, (Acts 10:44) The Word increases (Acts 6:7)
 - 2.) Impact is made upon the community (Acts 2:37-44, 46-47)
- b.) People setting their hearts to seek God (Jeremiah 29:12-14)

5. ARE YOU WILLING TO:

- a.) Repent of every known sin?
- b.) Separate yourself of every known habit?
- c.) Make everything right with your brother?
